Overview

- All JMO positions are recruited to during the NSW Annual Medical Recruitment campaign
- Centralised recruitment process
- Recruitment from this year onwards will be via the JMO Recruitment and Onboarding (ROB) platform
- Advertisements will be posted on:
 - The NSW Health Careers page: jobs.health.nsw.gov.au
 - The RCPA Jobs Listings page: rcpa.edu.au
- Eligibility: **ALL** AP training positions in NSW are accredited by the RCPA. Applicants **must** be eligible for registration with the RCPA at the time of application.

AP Training Program – Recruitment Streams




Key Dates

- **AMR Main Round Advertisement:** 22 July 21 up to 12 August 21*
- **Interviews (TBC):** Late August – Early September
- **Allocations and preliminary offers:** September
- **Commencement:** 7 February 2022

**Late applications not accepted unless there are system or technical issues preventing application AND contact has been made prior to advertisement end date.*

Application

- Locate advertisement on NSW Health Careers page
- Applications submitted via the JMO ROB portal
- Applications **must** be supported by responses to the Selection Criteria
- **Must** be supported by evidence of eligibility for an accredited RCPA training position

- Interviewees will be asked to complete a set of employment-related checks tasks
 - Tasks differ depending on whether you are internal to NSW Health or external

Allocations (AMR Applicants)

- Allocations will be determined based on:
 - The preferred applicants following interviews
 - Their preferences
 - The availability of training positions or vacancies at each site
- Connected Rural and Metro rotational positions

Commencement

- Orientation on first week
- Registration with the RCPA
